COVID-19, Good Health Clinic, and the Community

The pandemic has shined a light on the economic disparities in health care access. As a leader in providing healthcare for low-income, uninsured residents of the Florida Keys community, Good Health Clinic focused our efforts on ensuring our patients, and all those in need, had access to the medical care, testing, and PPE as needed to protect themselves and their families. Dedicated staff and supporters have allowed us to remain open and continue accepting new patients, many of whom lost their jobs as our local tourism economy was crippled for months. As we move into 2021, Good Health Clinic is committed to continuing our work in closing the economic gap in healthcare access and ensuring members of our community all have access to the care and support needed to function in this new world.

Mental Health Care

Anxiety and Depression are two leading concerns for our community, especially with COVID-19 creating unprecedented amounts of stress and fear. After much planning, Good Health Clinic has launched a mental health pilot program this fall. Through collaborative team care for our patients – bringing together medical, mental health, and care coordination personnel – we are facilitating positive health outcomes for our patients and removing the health barriers to achieving social and physical health goals.

What's that you say? Free hearing screening?

To support our patients and the community who are suffering with hearing loss, Good Health Clinic has partnered with Sertoma Speech and Hearing Foundation of Florida, Inc. to provide free hearing screenings on site, free phones for the limited hearing patients, and have the option to see an Audiologist.

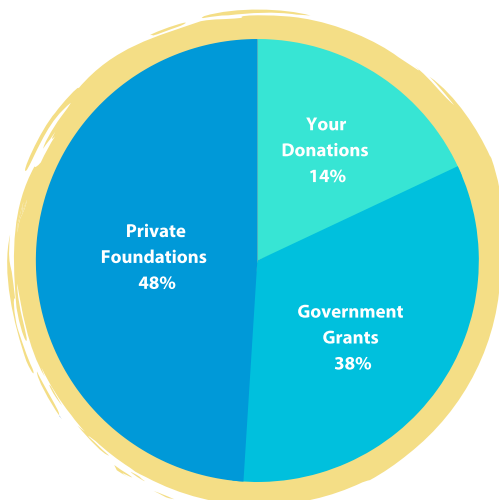

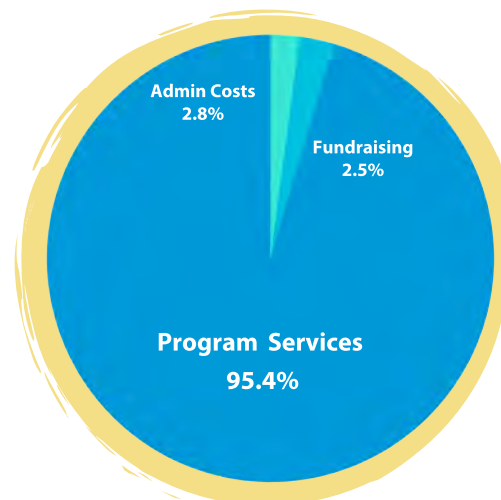
